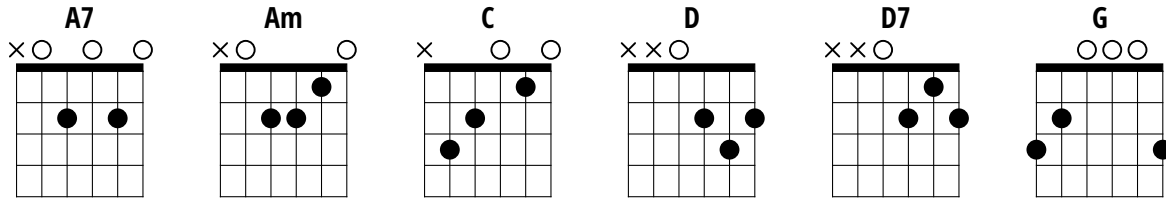


Jingle Bells
